- a. Approved
 - i. RDCK CIP SSKHRR (\$4,000) Osprey (\$1,446) KLWMP (\$4,000); NDCU beach CU (\$750); Columbia Power WQM (\$2,000) BCWF Harrop wetland (\$15,000)
 - Total approved for 2022 so far: \$166,495 (79% of budget, doesn't include donations of ~11K)
 - 1. Total budgeted expenses: \$209,459
 - Total applied: \$308,333.44 total denied: \$79,880 (mostly wage funding we weren't eligible for) total pending: \$56,880 + 2 wage funding grants with \$\$ not specified (in the \$20,000 range each)
 - 3. Percent success of total \$\$ applied vs total \$\$ awarded to date: 54%
 - 4. Meeting budget goal would require an additional \$42,964. Note that we are already ahead of 2021 funding total.
