Endorsement Guidelines – Draft 4; May 24, 2018 Friends of Kootenay Lake Stewardship Society (FoKLSS)

Preamble

The Board of Directors of Friends of Kootenay Lake is contacted, from time to time, to provide support for activities and campaigns related to the Lake and its basin. The following guidelines are intended to help identify whether a project or request for support for a project or campaign is suitable for endorsement. Criteria below examine the proposal's alignment with the Friends of Kootenay Lake mission, the goals outlined in our current Strategic Plan and with the values of the organization.

FoKL will consider supporting a project or campaign if it meets the criteria listed below. Final decisions will be at the discretion of the Board and will be made on a case-by-case basis.
