1. Finances:

 Concern about money owing from CBT as 73% of project completion is required to pay the money still owing; FoKL have completed 69%. The payback for not completing is \$6000. The project is from back in 2022;

Martin suggested a letter from the board asking for sympathetic consideration on the remaining.

- Sukhananda: Financial concern as to end of December and then? Small
 amounts coming in but not enough to be viable. We aren't in a position to apply

 move forward?
- If the anticipated grants (RDCK, Fortis) come in, we'll have about 6800. at year end. This includes CEBA repayment.
